**U.S. Special Envoy Graton Travels to Chad and Sudan from February 13 to 22
Will Visit N'Djamena, Juba, Kadugli and Khartoum**

Key objectives are to complete implementation of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement (CPA) and election preparations.

Excerpted Text:

Special Envoy Scott Graton will travel to Chad and Sudan this coming week for discussions with members of Sudan's People Liberation Movement (the SPLM), including President Kiir, on resolving the remaining issues around the full and complete implementation of the Comprehensive Peace Agreement. And then he will be in Khartoum on – for bilateral meetings with both the SPLM and the National Congress Party to discuss the census, referendum, Abyei, and all – and post-referendum issues.
